PRESENT SIMPLE	PRESENT CONTINUOUS
<ul> <li>Routines</li> <li>Repeated actions or events</li> <li>e.g. I usually <u>arrive</u> at my office at 8:30.</li> </ul>	- Things happening now e.g. The manager is interviewing a new applicant.
<ul> <li>Permanent situations</li> <li>General facts</li> <li>e.g. This company <u>produces</u> spare parts.</li> </ul>	- Temporary situations - Current projects e.g. I am not working this week.
- Future actions (events based on official calendars, timetables, programs) e.g. My train arrives in Seoul at 7:25.	- Fixed future arrangements (personal) e.g. I am meeting my boss tomorrow.
Often used with time expressions like: Never, rarely, hardly ever, sometimes, often, usually, always.	Often used with time expressions like:  Now, at the moment, at present, currently, these days.
