$$\underline{\underline{\text{grad}}} f = \frac{\partial f}{\partial x_1} \underline{e}_1 + \frac{\partial f}{\partial x_2} \underline{e}_2 + \frac{\partial f}{\partial x_3} \underline{e}_3$$

$$\underline{\underline{\text{grad}}} \underline{U} = \begin{pmatrix} \frac{\partial u_1}{\partial x_1} & \frac{\partial u_1}{\partial x_2} & \frac{\partial u_1}{\partial x_3} \\ \frac{\partial u_2}{\partial x_1} & \frac{\partial u_2}{\partial x_2} & \frac{\partial u_2}{\partial x_3} \\ \frac{\partial u_3}{\partial x_1} & \frac{\partial u_3}{\partial x_2} & \frac{\partial u_3}{\partial x_3} \end{pmatrix}$$

$$\underline{\text{div}} \underline{U} = \frac{\partial u_1}{\partial x_1} + \frac{\partial u_2}{\partial x_2} + \frac{\partial u_3}{\partial x_3}$$

$$\Delta f = \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial x_1^2} + \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial x_2^2} + \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial x_3^2}$$

$$\underline{\text{rot}} \underline{U} = \left(\frac{\partial u_3}{\partial x_2} - \frac{\partial u_2}{\partial x_3} \right) \underline{e}_1 + \left(\frac{\partial u_1}{\partial x_3} - \frac{\partial u_3}{\partial x_1} \right) \underline{e}_2 + \left(\frac{\partial u_2}{\partial x_1} - \frac{\partial u_1}{\partial x_2} \right) \underline{e}_3$$

$$\underline{\Delta} \underline{U} = \Delta u_1 \underline{e}_1 + \Delta u_2 \underline{e}_2 + \Delta u_3 \underline{e}_3$$

$$\underline{\text{grad}} f = \frac{\partial f}{\partial r} \underline{e}_r + \frac{1}{r} \frac{\partial f}{\partial \theta} \underline{e}_\theta + \frac{\partial f}{\partial z} \underline{e}_z$$

$$\underline{\underline{\text{grad}}} \underline{U} = \begin{pmatrix} \frac{\partial u_r}{\partial r} & \frac{1}{r} \left(\frac{\partial u_r}{\partial \theta} - u_\theta \right) & \frac{\partial u_r}{\partial z} \\ \frac{\partial u_\theta}{\partial r} & \frac{1}{r} \left(\frac{\partial u_\theta}{\partial \theta} + u_r \right) & \frac{\partial u_\theta}{\partial z} \\ \frac{\partial u_z}{\partial r} & \frac{1}{r} \frac{\partial u_z}{\partial \theta} & \frac{\partial u_z}{\partial z} \end{pmatrix}$$

$$\underline{\text{div}} \underline{U} = \frac{\partial u_r}{\partial r} + \frac{u_r}{r} + \frac{1}{r} \frac{\partial u_\theta}{\partial \theta} + \frac{\partial u_z}{\partial z}$$

$$\underline{\Delta} f = \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial r^2} + \frac{1}{r} \frac{\partial f}{\partial r} + \frac{1}{r^2} \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial \theta^2} + \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial z^2}$$

$$\underline{\text{rot}} \underline{U} = \left(\frac{1}{r} \frac{\partial u_z}{\partial \theta} - \frac{\partial u_\theta}{\partial z} \right) \underline{e}_r + \left(\frac{\partial u_r}{\partial z} - \frac{\partial u_z}{\partial r} \right) \underline{e}_\theta + \left(\frac{\partial u_\theta}{\partial r} + \frac{u_\theta}{r} - \frac{1}{r} \frac{\partial u_r}{\partial \theta} \right) \underline{e}_z$$

$$\underline{\text{grad}} f = \frac{\partial f}{\partial r} \underline{e}_r + \frac{1}{r} \frac{\partial f}{\partial \theta} \underline{e}_\theta + \frac{1}{r \sin \theta} \frac{\partial f}{\partial \varphi} \underline{e}_\varphi$$

$$\Delta f = \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial r^2} + \frac{2}{r} \frac{\partial f}{\partial r} + \frac{1}{r^2} \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial \theta^2} + \frac{1}{r^2 \tan \theta} \frac{\partial f}{\partial \theta} + \frac{1}{r^2 \sin^2 \theta} \frac{\partial^2 f}{\partial \varphi^2}$$
